Incentive Structure

The Program provides direct payment of financial incentives to Distributors who deliver energy efficient HVAC systems and ENERGY STAR® Smart Thermostats. The incentive structure has been simplified to be a 2-step process.

Step 1: Find the base incentive in the Base Table/Replace-on-Burnout (ROB) Table. **Step 2:** Choose any combination of applicable bonus incentives. These can include:

- Early Retirement (up to 15 years old)
- Heat Pump: Either replacing another Heat Pump or replacing an Electric Resistance furnace (strip heat)
- Mini Split: Either an AC or Heat Pump
- ENERGY STAR Certified Thermostats
- Downsizing
- Low/Moderate Income

Helpful Definitions

- **Replace-on-Burnout (ROB):** occurs when the homeowner is replacing a defective, non-functioning, HVAC system.
- Early Retirement (ER): occurs when the homeowner electively chooses to replace a functional HVAC system for a new system.
- ENERGY STAR Smart Thermostat: Dealer must install an ENERGY STAR certified Wi-Fi smart thermostat with a qualifying system and include it in the incentive application.
- **Downsizing:** The Dealer will need to install a smaller system than was originally installed. On a multiple-system home, each system that is downsized will be eligible for the downsizing incentive.
- Low/Moderate Income (LMI): HVAC system must be installed in one of ten qualifying communities and is eligible for double the base incentive.

Home Eligibility Requirements

- 1. The HVAC unit must be installed within the CenterPoint Energy distribution service territory. There are two methods to determine if a home is eligible:
 - a. Meter must say "CenterPoint Energy".



- b. Look up the address using this link: https://electricityplans.com/texas/esid-lookup/
- 2. Equipment must not receive incentives from any other CenterPoint Energy energyefficiency program.
- 3. Site must be designated as residential and must also be individually metered. Mastermetered properties are not eligible.

System Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Residential systems must meet or exceed the following efficiency requirements and must be within the following capacity requirements:
 - a. Split and mini-split A/C and heat pump systems:
 - i. 15.2 SEER2/10 EER2/7.5 HSPF2
 - ii. Cooling capacity between 15,000 to 65,000 BTUH (1 to 5 tons).
 - iii. System sized based on ACCA ManualJ8 and ACCA Manual S standards
 - b. Thermostats must be ENERGY STAR® certified
- 2. Mini-Split Install a high efficiency mini-split system in the following scenarios:
 - a. New Construction
 - b. Existing Construction new room addition (conditioning a previously unconditioned room, like a garage or sunroom)
 - c. Existing Construction replacing Central AC with multiple mini-splits: pre and post tonnage must be within ½ ton.
 - d. The following two scenarios apply when installing mini-split systems including Ducted, Non Ducted, Single, and Multi-split, HPs or ACs.

Scenario 1 –All Mini-Splits – Identify the base incentive amount using the system's SEER2 & BTUH ratings on Table #1. Mini-Splits are also eligible for a \$300 mini-split bonus incentive per table #3.

Scenario 2 –All Mini-Split Heat Pump systems replacing electric resistance heating -Identify the base incentive amount using the system's SEER2 & BTUH ratings on Table #1. When replacing electric resistance heating, the base incentive amount is doubled as indicated on Table #3. Lastly, Mini-Splits are also eligible for a \$300 mini-split bonus incentive per Table #3.

NOTE: The replacing electric resistance heating doubled incentive bonus can only be claimed for a maximum of 2 Mini-splits per household.

- 3. Central Split Systems installed in **New Construction** are eligible to receive incentives at a reduced rate. (Please reach out to ICF Program Staff or your Distributor)
- 4. All systems must be AHRI-matched.
- 5. Packaged, window or room air conditioning units are not eligible.

Dealer/Contractor Required Documentation

For all incentive Requests:

1



- Invoice with line item displaying the model and serial numbers of all newly installed equipment (including qualifying ENERGY STAR certified thermostat, if applicable)
- 2. Invoice with line item with that states "CenterPoint Energy Incentive" with the amount passed on to the customer.
- a. There is a **minimum incentive passthrough** requirement starting in 2025. Please reach out to your Distributor for exact incentive amounts.
- 3. AHRI reference number for the newly installed equipment.
- 4. Incentive Claim Form (Not required but recommended)
- 5. Dealer must run an approved load calculation and retain it on file for three years. No need to submit load calculation to distributor.
- 6. Notify the customer that they are participating in a CenterPoint Energy sponsored energy-efficiency program developed by the Public Utility Commission of Texas. Therefore, the customer may receive a site visit or phone call from CenterPoint Energy personnel to verify install specifications.

Additional documentation needed for Early Retirement (ER):

- Amperage meter photos
- Condenser nameplate photos

Additional documentation needed for Electric Resistance to Heat Pumps replacements:

• A photograph of the existing nameplate, including the model and serial numbers. Alternatively, a picture of the electric heat strips can be submitted if the nameplate is inaccessible or obscured.

Additional documentation needed for Downsizing Incentive Bonus:

- Summary pages of an ACCA approved Manual J8, including:
 - Retired Outdoor Unit Model and Serial Number
 - o Retired Outdoor Unit Manufacturer
 - o Estimated Square Footage of Conditioned Floor Area served by retired unit
 - o Photograph of Retired Outdoor Unit Nameplate

Additional information needed for Low/Moderate Income Bonus:

- Must be located in one of the ten qualifying communities, called Houston Complete Communities:
 - o Acres Homes
 - o Alief Westwood
 - Fort Bend Houston
 - o Gulfton
 - o Kashmere Gardens
 - o Magnolia Park Manchester
 - Near Northside
 - Second Ward
 - o Sunnyside
 - Third Ward

FAQ



Q: What are the incentives available for the 2025 Program?

A: Incentive amounts will be provided by a participating Distributor.

Q: Where do Dealers submit the completed incentive paperwork?

A: Dealers can either submit all paperwork to their salesperson at any participating Distributor or use the mobile app, Sightline Mobile. Please reach out to ICF staff for access.

Q: When can I expect my reimbursement?

A: All Distributors have different processing times, but generally, Dealers can expect funds 4 to 12 weeks after the Distributor submits all necessary documentation into the online portal.

Q: We do not do load calculations. Can we still participate?

A: No, we require load calculations. Your team can get free training on this and other best practices through the ICF Sightline Learning Center. Reach out to ICF staff for access.

Q: We gave the homeowner more than the **minimum incentive passthrough**. Will that affect the eligibility of my claim?

A: No. The minimum incentive passthrough is required, however, you are allowed and encouraged to pass on more than the minimum incentive passthrough if you wish to do so.
